Notice of Race

May 6-7, 2023

Event: The Corinthian Sailing Club (Organizing Authority) cordially invites you to an open regatta for all centerboard boats and the Corinthian Class Keelboat.

Rules: The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*. The Laser class rule requiring class legal sails is waived.

Entry: Registration may be completed online at www.cscsailing.org. Late registration (after Sunday, April 30, 2023) may be completed online or at the regatta site (on May 6, 2023) at 441 E Lawther Drive, Dallas, TX 75218. Sailing Instructions will be available online and at check in.

Classes: Three boats of any one design will race as a class. The starting order and class flag for each class will be announced at the skippers meeting and posted.

Fees:	Double handed boats advance, on-line \$50.00	
	Double handed boats, after Sun. April 30th\$60.00	
	Single handed boats advance, on-line	. \$25.00
	Single handed boats, after Sun. April 30th	.\$35.00

Entry fee includes beverages and Saturday and Sunday continental breakfast and lunch. Saturday after racing snacks, beverages and the Saturday dinner will be provided by CSC as part of its First Saturday in May dinner social event. Competitors may sign up for themselves, their families and guests for the Saturday dinner upon regatta registration at the cost of \$25.00 per person.

Courses: Courses covered by the CSC Sundays SI's will be used. The regatta SI's will have details.

Schedule

Saturday May 6, 2023

0900 – 1000 hrs: Check-in and late registration. Continental Breakfast.

1000 hrs: Skippers meeting.

1100 hrs: Warning signal for the first race.

1230 hrs (approx): Break for lunch.

1400 hrs: Second and third race back-to-back.

No first fleet warning signal after 1630 hrs.

CSC First Saturday in May Happy Hour and Dinner following the last race.

Sunday May 7, 2023

0800 – 0930 hrs: Continental Breakfast.

1000 hrs: Warning signal for the first race of the day.

- Two races are planned, back to back.
- No first fleet warning signal after 1200 hrs.

Lunch and awards presentation following the last race.

Scoring: The low point scoring system, Appendix A of RRS will be used except no score will be excluded. One race constitutes a regatta.

Prizes: Prizes will be awarded to the top 3 finishers in each class having ten or more competitors, the top 2 finishers in each class having six or more competitors and the top finisher in each class having five or fewer competitors. In addition, each prize winner from each fleet will have their name and place of finish permanently inscribed on the Commodore's Cup Trophy, a perpetual trophy displayed in the Corinthian Sailing Club clubhouse on a permanent basis.
