1. RULES

- A. Dallas Laser Fleet is the Organizing Authority.
- B. The event will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024.
- C. If there is a conflict between languages, the English text will take precedence.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- A. The sailing instructions (SIs) will be posted on the online website (www.dallaslaserfleet.org) no less than 10 days before the first scheduled race. Printed copies will be available at the check-in.
- B. Changes to the SI after the skippers' meeting will be posted at the CSC Clubhouse notice board only.

3. COMMUNICATION

- A. The CSC Notice Board shall be the windows near the french doors at the main clubhouse.
- B. Any changes to the NOR or SI will be posted online at www.dallaslaserfleet.org before the skippers' meeting.
- C. There shall be no cellular or radio communications among competitors with coaches or spectators while racing.

4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- A. The event is open to all skippers of boats that are class legal by the International Laser Class Association Class.
- B. Classes to be sailed include ILCA 7, ILCA 6, ILCA 4.
- C. Class membership is not required for regatta entry.
- D. Class membership is required for Grand Prix points to be awarded by ILCA.
- E. Skipper may join the class during check-in.

4. C. All competitors must be current members of ILCA North America or their equivalent national Laser Class Association. Non-members can join the class by completing registration online at <https://laser.org/about-joining>.

F. Registration can be made online at www.dallaslaserfleet.org. Registration can also be made in person at the check-in desk before the skippers' meeting.

5. FEES

- A. Early Entry Fee is \$100. Late Entry Fee of \$15 will be applied if registration is not made before Sept. 24, 2022
- B. Entry Fee includes: a regatta shirt; breakfast, lunch, dinner on Saturday; breakfast Sunday; leftovers for lunch on Sunday.
- C. Additional meal ticket can be purchased for \$25
- D. Payments can be made in check or cash during check-in. Online payments can be made during registration.

6. SCHEDULE

Competitors may store their boats on the club docks.
Competitors may conduct practice sails on the water.
Casual get together at the dock starting at 1800.

7. VENUE
 - A. The racing area will be on the waters of White Rock Lake in Dallas, TX.
8. COURSES
 - A. The courses to be sailed will be the configurations as described in the SIs.
9. SCORING
 - A. Low Point Scoring Appendix A will apply.
 - B. Three (3) races will constitute a regatta.
 - C. When fewer than five (5) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. When six (6) or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
10. HOUSING
 - A. Dallas Fleet members are willing to host housing for competitors on a first come first serve basis. Contact regatta@dallaslaserfleet.org to make a request for housing.
11. RISK STATEMENT
 - A. RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks.
12. PRIZES
 - A. Prizes will be awarded to the first through third place finishers in the ILCA 7 class.
 - B. Prizes will be awarded to at least the first finishers in the ILCA 6 and ILCA 4 classes.
13. FURTHER INFORMATION
 - A. There are no camping or overnight parking allowed in the park.
 - B. No alcohol in the park. Only within the gates of the club.
